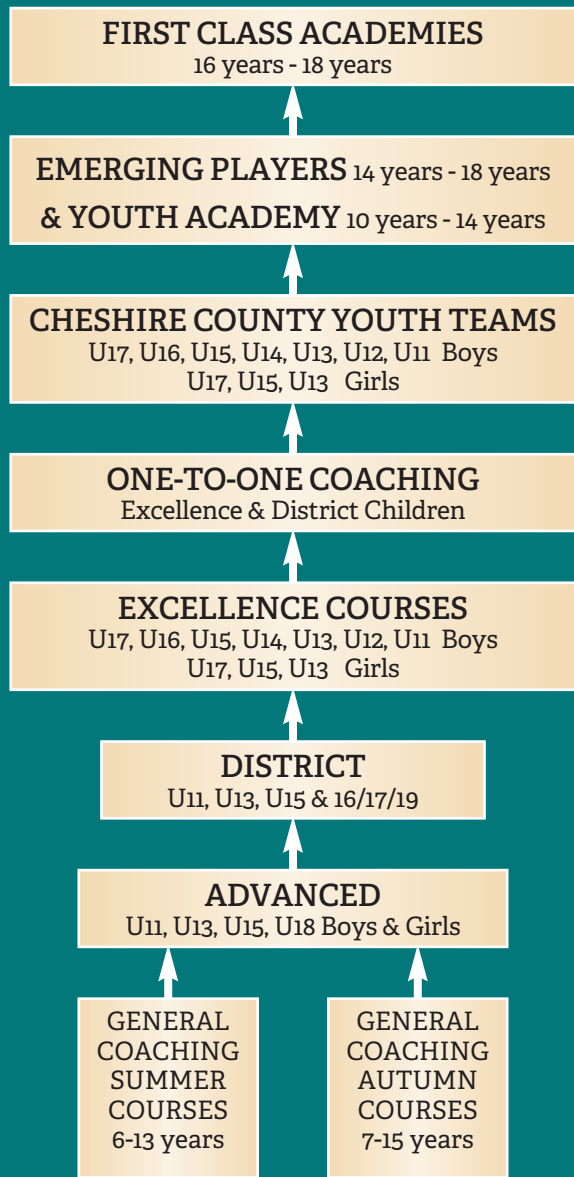

### SUMMER

- School holiday cricket courses – fun-filled, action packed weeks for Boys and Girls aged 6-13.
- ECB Clubmark clubs.
- Led by Level 3 coaches with DBS checks and first aid qualifications.
- Highlights include new competitions, specialist age group coaching and awards.
- A week not to be missed.

### AUTUMN

- Keep your eye in on one of Cheshire's six-week Autumn courses, at selected indoor centres.
- For Boys and Girls of all abilities aged 7-15
- A mix of nets, games and group coaching based on improving player performance.
- Led by Level 3 ECB coaches, with DBS checks and first aid qualifications.

### ADVANCED LEVEL COURSES NOV-JAN

- A challenging indoor coaching course for young cricketers (8-18 years) who have already achieved a high level of performance.
- Selection for these 10-week, two-hour courses is determined by the following criteria:  
*A "significant" contribution to school or club cricket;  
A recommendation from a CCB coach/Club coach;  
Players who have represented Cheshire age group teams the previous season.*

### DISTRICT LEVEL COURSES JAN-MAR

- A high performance coaching course for players nominated from the Advanced Course.
- Places will be offered to selected participants at U11, U13, U15 and 16/17/19.
- Some players will be selected for the District Festival, held in the Whit Bank Holiday week.

### EXCELLENCE LEVEL COURSE JAN-APR

- Places will be offered to the leading players in age group as selected by the CCB coaches from the Advanced Courses.
- 12 week Courses for Boys (U11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17) and Girls (U13, 15, 17) at specialist indoor centres.
- Cheshire's age group representative sides will be selected from these courses.
