

Job Description for Cricket Coach at Oakmere Cricket Club 2018

We require a committed and confident self-employed Coach to attend our training sessions to further develop our players and teams.

Specific coaching requirements:

1. To plan and lead weekly outdoor training sessions to be undertaken with senior players and invited talented juniors, from 24th April 2018.
2. If possible, to attend indoor training sessions (12th Feb to 19th March 2018).
3. To oversee & conduct risk assessment at all sessions.
4. To have knowledge and understanding of ECB Child Welfare procedures in relation to coaching responsibilities.
5. To conduct sessions in accordance with the appropriate ECB guidelines and good practice.
6. Encourage the players to act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times and ensure that the spirit of the game be promoted at all times.
7. To share good practise with all club coaches.
8. To ensure there is enough appropriate equipment and monitor equipment levels.
9. To present monthly progress reports to the cricket committee.

Person Specification – required coaching qualifications and experience:

1. Experienced Level 3 qualified coach preferred.
2. Highly motivated level 2 qualified coach also considered if :-
 - a. Actively pursuing level 3 qualification and/or
 - b. Combined with a proven track record of delivering results working with 16-18 year old and/or women cricketers.
3. Up to date DBS, First Aid and Working with Children certification, and public liability insurance.
4. Committed every week to the schedule detailed above.
5. Excellent communication skills and punctuality.
6. Excellent organisational skills.
