HAVE DEVELOPED TWO NEW COURSES FOR CLUBS
INVOLVED WITH JUNIOR CRICKET

The aim of the course for Junior Club Cricketers is to give participants enough knowledge of the most important and frequently applied Laws so that they:

- Know their responsibilities as a player or a captain
- Contribute to upholding the Spirit of the Game
- Know the Laws well enough as a batsman to avoid being dismissed unnecessarily and accept the decision when given out
- Know the Laws well enough as a bowler or a fielder to avoid being penalised and to take advantage of errors by the batsmen

A separate course for Adults and Senior Players wishing to umpire Club Junior games is designed initially to familiarise participants with ECB Regulations for Young Players and then consider the main provisions in the Laws for:

- The pitch and wickets including creases and the protected area
- Appeals and modes of dismissal including LBW
- Dead Ball, No Ball and Extras
- Substitutes and players leaving the field

The Junior Club Cricketers course is designed to take place over one evening whilst the course for Adults and Senior Players will take place over 3 separate evenings

It is intended that both courses should take place at the Clubs' own premises on mutually agreed dates. The cost of the first course being £5 per Junior and the Adults and Senior Players course will be £15 per person for the whole course
