#### **Cricket Committee 15 June issues**

I raised the concern whether 1<sup>st</sup> team players rained off on a Sat could play 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> XI cricket the following day. I was reminded of regulation 12 on handbook page 125 – ‘in the case of a club including players at an inappropriate level, the league may take action including the deduction of points’. In ignorance I authorised one such request last weekend **but will not do so in future!**

I was advised that Year 7 pupils **MUST NOT** appear in senior cricket matches within the league

We accept that 7pts are guaranteed to either side in games reduced to less than 80 overs – however I was told to keep an eye out for any cases where this regulation is abused. It is likely that at the next AGM we will propose allowing 10 of the 80 overs to be lost before the 7pt guarantee comes in.
